THE PIED MOUTET RIDGE

To access the Pied Moutet ridge you need to take the path on the left after the ski slope. This path will first take you to the restaurant "La bergerie Kanata", and then higher up. Return a long the same itinerary. Close proximity to a ski slope.

Round trip 3h30

LES PERRONS

An initiation to snowshoeing...

Follow the path at the bottom of the slopes and after having passed the Diable chairlift you will proceed to a traced trail that will lead you to a bus car park and will form a loop.

VENOSC VILLAGE

Start at the bottom of the Vallée Blanche chairlift, in front of the Mont de Lans information point (entrance of the resort).

To the right of the chairlift take the trail following the undergrowth for 300m. After carefully crossing the ski slopes you have two options:

- The road in front of you leading to the restaurant KANATA (15min).
- The narrow trail to your right which will take you to a junction with different signposted directions

► PINK SIGNPOSTING

20min

Turn right on the downhill path and go back towards the bridge and car park at the entrance of the resort.

▶ BLUE SIGNPOSTING

Durée 1h30/2h

Carry on along the path. In 50m you will come across two hiking routes. Take the path to your right which will take you to the Molière farm-restaurant. In 15m you can either:

- ► Go straight ahead to the Molière restaurant
- Or right along the trail that overlooks the farm and takes you back up to the resort.

GREEN SIGNPOSTING 20min

Take the uphill path on your left. At the intersection, follow the orange arrow going up to your left. Once on the plateau, you will have a stunning view of the resort. Small right and left turns will take you up to a higher trail leading to the Kanata restaurant. Once you reach the La Côte ski slope you can:

- ► Turn left and go back down towards the Vallée Blanche chairlift
- Carefully cross the ski slopes and go up to Kanata.



OTHER TRAILS

Les balcons du Soleil – Kanata: starts behind the "Prince des Ecrins" building. After having crossed the Balcons du Soleil, walk past the snow cannons and carefully cross the Super Venosc ski slope. Follow the path below the forest line which overlooks the resort and arrives above the Kanata restaurant (Be careful, you will cross two ski slopes: vallée blanche 2 and 3)

Follow the black tracing on the map.
