

RULES | COMPETITION EARLY BOOKING SUMMER 2023

ARTICLE 1 - Organiser and duration of the competition

2 Alpes Réservation - Les 2 Alpes Tourist Office, located in Les 2 Alpes, is organising an Early Booking competition for the summer season (i.e. from 8 July to 27 August), the winners of which will be chosen by drawing lots according to the conditions defined below. The competition will run from Friday 3 March to Sunday 19 March at midnight.

ARTICLE 2 - Conditions of participation in the competition

- 2.1. Contest with obligation to buy a stay of at least 1 week on the les2alpes.com website between 1/07/23 and 28/08/23.
- 2.2. Participation in the competition implies irrevocable and unconditional acceptance of the terms and conditions of these rules.
- 2.3. The competition is limited to one entry per person. Participation in the competition is strictly personal and nominative. Only one prize will be awarded.
- 2.4. Failure to comply with the conditions of participation set out in these Rules shall result in the Participant's participation being null and void.

ARTICLE 3 - Principle of the competition/participation methods

Each participant must meet the conditions of the game if he/she wants to have a chance of winning the prize.

ARTICLE 4 - Designation of winners

The Organiser will designate the winners by drawing lots from among all the people who have made a reservation of at least one week for the summer season. A draw will be held on Tuesday 21st March 2023.

ARTICLE 5 - Prizes

Gift n°2: 1 Les 2 Alpes cap + 1 activity pass

Gift n°3: 1 activity pass



ARTICLE 6 - Awarding of prizes and terms of use of prizes

The Organiser of the competition will contact the winner by e-mail and inform them of the procedures to follow to access their prize. No mail will be sent to participants who did not win, only the winners will be contacted. Winners must respond within two weeks of the email being sent and provide their full contact details. If the winner does not reply within two weeks of the e-mail being sent, he or she will forfeit the prize and will not be entitled to any indemnity, prize money or compensation whatsoever. In this case, the prizes will be awarded to a substitute designated in the draw for the session concerned. The winners must comply with these rules. If they do not meet the criteria of these rules, their prize will not be awarded and will be acquired by the Organiser. To this end, participants authorise all verifications concerning their identity, age, contact details or the loyalty and sincerity of their participation. Any false declaration, false indication of identity or postal address will result in the immediate elimination of the participant and the acquisition of the prize by the Organiser.

The prizes will be collected from the Tourist Office, Place des 2 Alpes, during the winners' stay.

ARTICLE 7 - Liability

The Organiser may not be held liable for the impossibility of contacting each winner, nor in the event of loss, theft or damage to the prize during its transportation. The Organiser cannot be held responsible for any errors in the name, address and/or contact details provided by the persons who took part in the competition. Furthermore, the Organiser of the competition declines all responsibility for any incidents that may occur during the enjoyment of the prize awarded and/or due to its use and/or its consequences, in particular the enjoyment of a prize by a minor, who remains under the full and total responsibility of a person with parental authority. The Organiser reserves the right, if circumstances so require, to shorten, extend, modify, interrupt, postpone or cancel the competition, without being held liable. However, any modification will be the subject of an amendment which will be posted on the site and sent free of charge to any person who has requested the rules in writing. The Organiser declines all responsibility in the event of malfunction preventing access and/or the proper running of the competition, in particular due to external acts of malice. The use of robots or any other similar process allowing participation in the competition by mechanical or other means is prohibited, and any violation of this rule will result in the definitive elimination of the creator and/or user. The Organiser may cancel all or part of the competition if it appears that fraud has occurred in any form whatsoever, in particular in a computerised manner in the context of participation in the competition or the determination of the winners. In this case, it reserves the right not to award any prize.
