Les 2 Alpes SKI AREA

The Isère department's iconic ski destination, Les 2 Alpes has garnered an international reputation thanks to its altitude (the highest skiable area in France) culminating at 3600 m. The high peaks between 3,000 and 3,600m ensure that you can ski on natural snow in all seasons. The verticality of the ski area offers a vertical drop of 2,300 m between 3,600m and 1,300 m (including 10 km on a blue run between 3,600 m and 1,600 m), and the higher you go, the more accessible the slopes are to intermediate skiers. Whether you're a couple, a family or a group of friends, a beginner, an intermediate or an expert, you can ski together or on parallel runs and find each other easily. And above all, the resort is very varied: marked runs, off-piste, fun runs and a slalom stadium.

Les 2 Alpes ski area's TOP 10

1 - Les 2 Alpes ski area peaks at 3600 m. Quality skiing and guaranteed skiing!

2 - Les 2 Alpes ski area is vertical (3600 m to 1300 m). Long vertical drops on skis!

3 - 75% of the ski area is above 2100 m.

4 - Les 2 Alpes ski area is going from strength to strength with an incredible expansion of its slopes and lifts, including the Jandri 3S at the start of the 2024/2025 winter season.

5 - A departure and return to the resort on skis or via the ski lifts (Hybrid-lift of Belle Étoile, Jandri 3S, hybrid-lift of Le Diable).

6 - A snow front equipped and adapted for beginners, including 3 free ski lifts. Conveyor belts, the latest generation of ski lifts, make everything easy!

7 - The Vallée Blanche sector is accessible to all thanks to a beautiful green slope and easy-to-access ski lifts (cable car and hybrid-lift).

8 - 2 Alpes snowpark (Toura sector - 2600 m), the freestyle area for all, beginners and novices, young and old alike!

9 - Its Freeride potential is exceptional (800Ha) with routes between 3600m and 1300m, a less-frequented equivalent of La Grave where everyone can find a route to suit their level and their desires. As with all off-piste itineraries, you'll need advice, support (from the guide office or ski school) and safety equipment (avalanche transceiver, shovel, probe).

10 - The higher you go in Les 2 Alpes, the more accessible the slopes become. Beginner skiers who start at a low altitude can ski to over 3000 m by the end of their stay and come back down via the Jandri 3S !

Listening to the high altitude domaine !

For four decades, the area between 3000m and 3600m in Les 2 Alpes has been meticulously measured and preserved by engineers from the ski area development company. Before any conservation **work is carried out, in-depth analyses** are carried out to monitor the development of the glacier and its snow. Today, snow groomers are equipped with GPS and radar systems capable of measuring the depth of the snow in relation to a reference line established at the start of the season.

Such precise analyses, followed by statistical calculations, make it possible to define **the impact of visitor numbers** on the glacier, the level of melting, and the actions to be taken, such as artificial snow, snow trap techniques and grooming. The snow engineers and their team organise the work of the snow guns and water management, daily grooming and the installation of snow or wind barriers. These wooden structures and snow lines - half-tubes dug to trap the snow - slow down melting and help preserve the glacier. Thanks to its north-westerly exposure and domed shape with a gentle slope, the glacier benefits from less melting, as the sun's rays are dispersed over a wider area than on a steep slope.


Since the 1980s, Les 2 Alpes has been **working hard to protect** its high-altitude ski area. At the time, eight machines were used daily to groom the slopes in summer from 1pm until nightfall. This is still the case today, but fewer machines are

needed because they are more precise and efficient. At the end of each summer, the glacier is sculpted into the shape of a cradle **to hold back the first precipitation of winter**, a tradition which continues today with modern, efficient techniques: snow traps and snow lines. Spring/summer skiing is still a reality, thanks to meticulous maintenance and these advanced preservation techniques.

Like all glaciers on the planet, Les 2 Alpes is affected by global warming. However, thanks to its geographical profile, daily maintenance and snow trap systems, melting has been slowed down. Skiing on the glacier and grooming it increase the snow's mechanical strength, preserving it and regenerating the ice.

In 2019, the ice level had even risen by 60 cm in some places (where we had been able to produce snow with water from lake 3200), proof of the effectiveness of the methods used.

The constant attention paid to Les 2 Alpes glacier over the last 40 years attests to the resort's commitment to protecting this precious natural heritage. Thanks to innovative techniques and a constant concern for preservation, **the ski area continues to offer an exceptional skiing experience while preserving the high altitude.**





28 OCTOBER TO 29 NOVEMBER

AVALANCHE BLASTER TRAINING

6th edition

ANENA (Association Nationale pour l'Étude de la Neige et des Avalanches - National Association for the Study of Snow and Avalanches) is organising four courses in mountain shooting and slow-release firefighting at Les 2 Alpes. For the 6th year running, around a hundred piste-attendants will be trained at Les 2 Alpes!

2 TO 13 DECEMBER

AVALANCHE RESCUE DOG HANDLER TRAINING

19th edition

ANENA will be training dog handlers at Les 2 Alpes from 2 to 13 December 2024. Around twenty pairs will take 88 hours of practical and theoretical lessons over 11 days: regulations and characteristics of avalanche rescue, identification of the different methods of getting to the search area, composition of the intervention bag, driving the dog and practical exercises in the field under real conditions. The course culminates in the Brevet National de Maître-Chien d'Avalanche, recognised by the French Ministry of the Interior.

► An exceptional customer experience, skier or not, at 3400 m

Reaching Les 2 Alpes ski area is now easy, fast and comfortable thanks to the Jandri 3S gondola lift (new in 2025) and the funicular railway (completely renovated). In just 17 minutes, the Jandri 3S gondola lifts skiers and pedestrians from 1650 m to 3200 m, after which Pedestrians can then take the funicular up to 3400 m. Make way for an immersive journey and breathtaking views! At 3400 m, visitors can enjoy a 360° panorama, from Mont Blanc to Mont Ventoux, via the Massif Central and Italy. The Belvédère des Écrins, a «step into the void», accessible to skiers and walkers, boasts spectacular views of the Écrins National Park. The ice cave, also located at 3400 m, promises a unique experience. Immersing yourself at 3400 m promises to be a thrilling experience ! Traditionally offered in the summer by Les 2 Alpes mountain guides office (mountain leaders) the glacier hike is now available in March. This is a supervised outing between 3400 m and 3600 m and is a great adventure, offering the opportunity to climb a summit in crampons (the 2 Alpes summit), roped up and supervised by a mountain guide. With just 200 metres of ascent, the hike is accessible to people aged 10 and over, making it a risk-free introduction to mountaineering, offering thrills, incredible scenery and a breath of fresh air. ► Get away from it ALL with electric mountain biking on snow!

In Les 2 Alpes, several specialists (Trail Hunter MTB, Chez Bob...) offer electric mountain bike or fat bike outings on the snowy slopes. Riding on snow is a different way to spend your holiday in Les 2 Alpes, combining the thrill of the snow with the challenge of riding. The itineraries are suitable for all levels and offer up to 400 metres of ascent for the most experienced riders, while evening outings are also available. ► Aerial temptations aboard a two-seater paraglider

between 2400 m (top of the Diable hybride lift) and the resort at 1650 m, a downhill flight facing the Ecrins National Park and above the resort. Thrills guaranteed and superb views of the mountains and Les 2 Alpes! On a clear day, the tandem takes off, skis on, at 2400m over the Diable sector. The flight is downhill at the start of the season, but as the thermals change, the flight becomes more aerial, with views over the Ecrins National Park, Les 2 Alpes, the Vénéon valley (Venosc and the turquoise waters of the Vénéon river), the Roc de la Muzelle, the Pic de Venosc and the Croix de Pied-Moutet. The flight is up, down, round and it's a real eyeful!

BEHIND THE SCENES IN THE SKI AREA

► A morning with the ski patrollers in Les 2 Alpes: FIRST TRACKS SKIING

Every Tuesday from 8am, the piste patrollers at Les 2 Alpes invite holidaymakers to discover what goes on behind the scenes at the «SKI PREMIÈRES TRACES» event. This unique experience allows participants to immerse themselves in the daily life of the piste patrollers: learning about their jobs, organising the day, making the pistes safe, informing customers, rescue equipment, working with the dog handlers, fireworks and opening the pistes. Customers have the privilege of opening the slopes alongside the ski patrollers.

This extraordinary morning experience is followed by a gourmet breakfast at an altitude of 2600 m.

► An afternoon with snow groomer drivers: SIDE BY SIDE WITH THE GROOMERS AT 3200 M

Riding a snow groomer is a dream for many skiers and is a great way to see what it's like to work in the snow. The slopes are groomed every day, and work continues even after the ski area has closed. Preserving the snow cover requires constant maintenance, from the time the slopes close until the early hours of the morning in winter. These professionals, passionate about their work, enjoy the peace and beauty of the landscape, taking in sunsets and sunrises, and sharing an afternoon with them is a chance to enter their world. This 30-minute immersion, offered every Wednesday between 1.30pm and 4.30pm (+ Thursdays during school holidays), takes place at altitudes of between 3,200m and 3,600m. Such initiatives offer holidaymakers a rare opportunity to understand the challenges and beauty of these jobs, which are essential to the smooth running of the Les 2 Alpes ski area.

A HISTORIC JOURNEY BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF VENOSC, ITS HAMLETS AND LES 2 ALPES

In the heart of the Vénéon valley, on the edge of the Écrins National Park, nestles the picturesque village of Venosc. Accessible in just 8 minutes by the Venosc cable car from the resort, this enchanting village boasts a typical Oisans setting, where centuries-old houses tell stories of days gone by. The cobbled, pedestrianised streets of Venosc invite you to stroll, far from the hustle and bustle of modern life. A leisurely stroll leads through charming alleyways, lined with shops that wind their way along the streets. In vaulted halls and characterful houses, passionate craftsmen and women present quality products: wooden objects, leather, jewellery, fabrics, pottery, honey, candles, scents, decorations and miniatures for children. These craft treasures reflect the know-how and passion of the local people.

Every Tuesday from 10am to 12pm, the village offers a guided tour, where professionals from the Tourist Office, who love the Vénéon valley, will be

on hand to help you discover the rich history of this region. The 2-hour tour immerses holidaymakers in the geology, geography and captivating anecdotes of Venosc and its hamlets. You'll learn how the inhabitants of the past survived and lived through the centuries, right up to the creation of the resort of Les 2 Alpes. A trip to Venosc is like stepping back in time, offering a unique perspective on life in the past and the evolution of this iconic region of the Alps. Whether you're a history buff, a nature lover or just curious, Venosc and its hamlets promise an enriching and unforgettable experience.



The ski area company SATA Group-AEON, which has been responsible for the ski lifts in Les 2 Alpes since 2020, is seeking to modernise and transform the ski area into one that is even more accessible to everyone, all year round and for all sporting and non-sporting activities (cycling, mountain biking, hikers, runners, pedestrians, ski tourers, people with reduced mobility, etc.).

After the completion of the Super Venosc gondola lift, the 3 hybrid-lifts (Diable, Vallée Blanche and Belle Étoile), the redesign of the lower slopes (beginners) and the redevelopment of the Vallée Blanche sector, a new page is being turned with the replacement of the Jandri Express gondola lift, the backbone of Les 2 Alpes, by the Jandri 3S. This new lift is the biggest new development in Les 2 Alpes and the biggest project in the French Alps in the last 10 years, notable for its technical prowess, its excellence, its customer experience, its undeniable access to the guaranteed snow and its exemplary construction site. All these new developments are a guarantee for the future of the region.

«This project is a signature for the next 50 years! It's a comprehensive, structured project designed for all our customers, for all types of skiing and for all seasons. It incorporates not only an economic dimension (SATA Group-AEON is an economic player that gives life to the Oisans region) and a social dimension (ensuring the well-being and employment of local people), but also an environmental dimension (we live in the region, so we are the first to be concerned by our nature, we are the first ecologists of our mountain and there is no question of destroying our nature. Everything is designed to enhance and protect it», says Fabrice Boutet, Director of SATA Group-AEON

This new state-of-the-art POMA lift redefines the standards of mountain transport. The choices made by SATA Group-AEON and the municipality are based on modernity, flow, accessibility and comfort, in strict compliance with the environment and the recommendations of the local and administrative authorities. The Jandri 3S project, like all current redevelopments, considers the environment, local and regional life and the changing needs of Les 2 Alpes customers.

THE JANDRI 3S REPLACES THE FORMER JANDRI EXPRESS THIS WINTER 2024/2025

This winter, the Jandri 3S will replace the Jandri Express ski lift, which dates back to 1985. No longer meeting today's needs, it requires a great deal of maintenance work, but above all the capacity to take skiers from the bottom of the pistes is no longer sufficient. The new lift will double the capacity (from 1,700 to 3,000 people per hour) and improve customer comfort. It will enable skiers, pedestrians, mountain bikers and others to be lifted from the resort at 1650 m to 3200 m, in all seasons and in a record time of 17 minutes instead of 40 minutes today. It will also be more reliable in the face of weather conditions such as wind. It will be made up of 7 pylons instead of the current 17, for less visual pollution.

THE JANDRI 3S : A technical feat

The resort of Les 2 Alpes is about to enter a new era thanks to an incredible achievement orchestrated by the ski area development company SATA Group-AEON: the Jandri 3S. This new gondola lift represents a major technical advance in several respects.

► Cutting-edge technology from POMA

SATA Group-AEON chose POMA's 3S technology. Jean-Marc Griellier, Project Manager at Poma, explains: « The 3S is a combination of the best gondola and cableway systems. Made up of two carrying cables and a hauling cable, it is a silent, high-performance device, suitable for long spans and high winds, even above 28 m/s. This technology facilitates high throughput and enables long distances to be covered, as in Les 2 Alpes, between 1600 m and 3200 m. What's more, there will only be seven pylons instead of the current seventeen, an ingenious and virtuous feat, guaranteeing less impact on the environment, less maintenance and greater energy savings.»

► A visionary project for the mountains

Fabrice Boutet, Director of SATA Group-AEON, points out that « the technology of the 3S system rises to the challenge of the SATA Group-AEON ski area company to make the mountains accessible to everyone, all year round, for all types of activity, by means of a modern, comfortable lift with less impact on nature ». The Jandri 3S is also the first system to run at a speed of 8 m/s, doubling throughput to 3,000 people per hour and reducing the time taken to climb the mountain from 40 minutes to 17 minutes.


► A colossal and ingenious project

Building this gondola lift required impressive logistics: over 40 kilometres of cables to install, pylons up to 50 metres high and difficult weather conditions. Up to 450 workers were mobilised at three stations, with a concrete plant installed at 2600 m (in summer 2023) to minimise lorry rotations and transport times. A base camp was set up around the intermediate station, at an altitude of 2600 m, providing accommodation for 120 workers on site, with the La Toura mountain restaurant supplying meals. This arrangement saved time and ensured the safety of the teams..

► Technology for energy and environmental efficiency

The Jandri 3S is also notable out for its energy efficiency, with the buildings' energy being optimised by recovering the heat emitted by the machines, which is used to heat the structures via heat pumps. Although the use of photovoltaic panels is limited by exposure and snow clearance constraints, the departure station and cabins are equipped with on-board intelligence, making them autonomous.

The completion of the Jandri 3S marks a decisive turning point for Les 2 Alpes. Combining cutting-edge technology, respect for the environment and a positive economic impact, the new gondola embodies a modern and ambitious vision of the destination's future. It also confirms the resort's status as an innovator, ready to take on the challenges of the 21st century. .



THE JANDRI 3S : Guaranteed snow access

Les 2 Alpes ski area is taking another step forward in its commitment to skiers with the launch of the Jandri 3S, a state-of-the-art lift that not only revolutionises mountain transport, but also guarantees exceptional «4-season» snow cover. This ambitious project illustrates Les 2 Alpes' determination to offer an uninterrupted, high-quality skiing experience.

► A heritage of high summits

The quest for the highest peaks in Les 2 Alpes began in the 1970s. In 1972, the glacier was climbed using small white gondolas, followed by a cable car and multicoloured gondolas, reaching an altitude of 3200 m. Such infrastructure, although nowhere near today's technological standards, already made it possible to enjoy impressive vertical drops and guaranteed snow.

► Fast, direct access to the high altitude ski area

The Jandri 3S provides direct, fast access to the high-altitude ski area, located between 3200 m and 3600 m, guaranteeing high-quality natural snow from late November to July (depending on snow conditions). With a transport capacity of 3,000 people per hour, this new gondola considerably reduces waiting times and maximises skiing time, enabling visitors to take full advantage of the exceptional conditions on the summits.

► An infrastructure with climate-resilience

Thanks to its tri-cable suspension system (3S), the Jandri 3S offers unrivalled stability and reliability, even in difficult weather conditions. This robustness means that the service can be maintained around the clock, ensuring regular transport of skiers to the snow-covered areas of the high altitude domain. The cabins, designed to withstand strong winds (up to 28m/s) and snowstorms, guarantee a comfortable and safe experience for all users.

► Proactive season management

The development of the Jandri 3S is part of a broader strategy of proactive management of the ski season by Les 2 Alpes, in which by anticipating climatic variations and investing in robust, efficient infrastructure, the resort ensures that the slopes remain open and skiable throughout the season. This proactive approach reassures visitors and builds loyalty among ski enthusiasts, who can plan their holidays with confidence, knowing that they will enjoy optimum conditions. After all, the ski season lasts for 3 seasons, from the end of November to July!

► Economic impact and tourist appeal

The snow guarantee offered by the Jandri 3S has a significant impact on the appeal of the resort to tourists and the local economy. By ensuring an extended, high-quality ski season, Les 2 Alpes is boosting its appeal, boosting business for shops, accommodation and catering services and consolidating the resort's position as a destination of choice for skiers from all over the world.

The ultra-modern device promises to transform the daily lives of skiers and mountain enthusiasts, offering the perfect blend of comfort, speed and advanced technology. This innovation demonstrates Les 2 Alpes' commitment to putting the customer experience at the heart of its development.

► Comfort and elegance at the top

The Jandri 3S is distinguished by its spacious, well-equipped cabins (32 including 24 seats), designed to offer passengers optimum comfort. Each cabin is equipped with ergonomic seats and large picture windows, allowing passengers to enjoy spectacular panoramic views throughout the journey. The materials used, both robust and aesthetically pleasing, create a welcoming, modern atmosphere, ideal for enjoying the climb to the summits, relaxed and in record time.

► Unrivalled speed

With a transport capacity of 3,000 people per hour, the Jandri 3S reduces waiting times, allowing skiers and others to spend more time on the slopes and less time queuing. The construction of the new stations also marks the new architectural signature of Les 2 Alpes, in which the departure station, at an altitude of 1650 m, has been designed as an open space to accommodate new airport-style sales facilities, with extensive support services. Amenities such as public toilets, staff changing rooms, technical maintenance rooms, grooming machine garages and meeting areas will also be provided, while the intermediate station will offer a comfortable non-skiing room where users can enjoy hot drinks and snacks in bad weather. THE JANDRI 3S : An exemplary project

The Jandri 3S is technologically advanced, but above all it has been designed to respect and protect the environment.

► Preserving biodiversity

It was possible to build Jandri 3S because it respects its environment and the mandatory recommendations of the administrative authorities. KARUM was commissioned to assess the environmental impact of the Jandri 3S site, assessing biodiversity, water and soil to draw up recommendations for avoidance, reduction and compensation measures. On this basis, several zones were marked and delimited to block access to floral areas, wetlands and wildlife and preserve biodiversity. The construction of a new ski lift means that Les 2 Alpes and the wider region will be able to live sustainably today and for generations to come.

► Preserving water resources

Alp' Etudes was involved in water management to avoid contaminated water, with water reserves, also known as catchment areas, being protected because they are vulnerable, especially during major developments and the comings and goings of machinery (even if this was very limited). In fact, wastewater and run-off water often return to these sites/reserves, so measures need to be taken to protect this water from passing machinery and the worksite itself. Wastewater was treated on site at a micro purification plant set up for the worksite. This will also be used for the station's final needs, so rainwater has been filtered locally to ensure that it reaches the catchment fields without too many pollutants.

► Reasonable and sustainable thanks to the involvement of local and regional companies

The Jandri 3S project has brought together and surrounded itself with leading local companies. In addition to POMA, the well-known French ski lift manufacturer, around twenty local and regional companies have signed up to the adventure and are proud to have taken up the challenge. **«I'm so proud to have been able to work on this project»** says Marie Davy, architect with ATEAM. The project's priority has always been to work with local experts, so these companies naturally responded to the call and are proud to be involved in the Jandri 3S project. In this way, SATA Group-AEON is playing its part in the economic development of the region and in guaranteeing sustainable living in the Oisans area.

► Earthworks and re-grassing

FAMY was called in to manage and conserve the extracted topsoil and work backfill in a sustainable manner. The extracted soil is arable by nature, as it contains all the biodiversity, roots and root systems, so the original soil is reused instead of being disposed of hundreds of kilometres away, thereby limiting the carbon impact of these developments on our environment and preserving the rich soil already present. In the autumn, the company will get down to the business of re-grassing or re-vegetating the areas that have been worked on.

► Electricity in Les 2 Alpes: 100% carbon-free power

The electricity used in Les 2 Alpes is carbon-free. Some of it comes from an EDF hydroelectric source, while all new developments, where possible, are fitted with photovoltaic panels, and the surplus electricity produced is sold back to the Enedis group. Some of today's facilities operate with a high degree of autonomy. In the future, electricity will be 100% carbon-free.

The Jandri 3S in Les 2 Alpes is much more than just a ski lift. Every aspect of its construction has been designed to **reduce its environmental impact**. Les 2 Alpes is reaffirming its commitment to protecting the natural treasures that make up the richness of its ski area, while offering its visitors an **unforgettable and respectful experience**. ► Another new feature of Les 2 Alpes ski area is the renovation of the funicular railway located at 3100m

Like the Jandri 3S, which allows you to ascend from 1650 m to 3200 m, the funicular provides an underground lift enabling skiers, pedestrians and other visitors to reach an altitude of 3400 m. Dating back to 1989, this facility is undergoing a complete renovation to ensure a smooth, high-quality experience from the resort to the summits. The building, both inside and out, and its inclined lift have been completely renovated, with the machine room being enhanced and a new lighting system guides users to the exit at 3400 m.
